**Title: Solar PV Engineer**

An exciting opportunity has arisen to join an expanding Solar PV Asset Management Company responsible for the management of approaching 11,000 Domestic and small commercial rooftop Solar PV systems throughout England, Wales and Scotland. The main focus of this role will be to conduct reactive and preventative operations and maintenance visits as required. We are looking to recruit a Solar PV engineer experienced in installation and maintenance work associated with Domestic and Commercial scale rooftop Solar PV systems.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- To conduct reactive and scheduled preventative maintenance visits nationally. This will involve system testing and fault diagnosis of all areas relating to the design, installation and communication (with our tailored monitoring platforms) of rooftop Domestic and Commercial Solar PV systems.
- Travel to installed sites across England and Wales together with overnight stays where required to meet Operational requirements of the business.
- To work with various parties and deliver according to different working practices.
- To ensure personal health and safety procedures are followed at all times and risks are assessed and mitigated effectively.
- To assess and (where reasonable) remedy problems caused as a result of poor installations. These might include roof leaks, poor system performance and issues defined as dangerous.
- To complete all necessary documentation associated with Domestic Solar PV maintenance, repairs, insurance and warranty claims.

- Experience of commissioning of G83 and G59 regulated Solar PV system.

- 2394 Test and Inspect (Dwelling only).
- Strong technical understanding of Domestic Solar PV and the ability to effectively convey technical issues to a lay person.
- Experience of working with different roof types and structures.
- Confident with working at heights.

- Mobile Elevated Working Platforms license and or experience working with.
- A team player with excellent interpersonal, communication and customer service skills who can work in a team or as an individual.
- At least 12 months experience of Rooftop domestic Solar PV, maintenance work would be a distinct advantage.
- Good computer literacy and ability to use technology remotely is a must.
- A Flexible and adaptable approach and work ethic with the ability to achieve tight deadlines and think independently.
